Twine Field Conservation Campaign

The Twinefield in North Truro at Pond Road is an open space/upland meadow not found elsewhere on the Lower Cape. It provides plants and animals an essential breeding ground and a nutrient-rich field in which to thrive. The Twine Field also connects to nearby conserved land. When purchased, the land will include a public walking path for visitors to enjoy the natural beauty and a protected view of this rare and endangered habitat. Residents of Cape Cod are hoping to preserve the land by purchasing it through several fundraising options, including a Silent Art Auction, public funding, and donations, thereby saving it from development which would mostly likely include nine new structures with a road between them.

You're invited to be part of the Silent Auction and offer a work of art that collectors and supporters will want to purchase. You will determine the Reserve price which will be the amount you will receive for the work once it has sold. Anything above your take home total will be donated to the Conservation effort. We ask you to remember that this is a fundraiser so please consider the importance of this effort when setting your Reserve. Of course, should you be so inclined, you may donate 100% of the selling price of your work! Post Office Gallery is sponsoring and hosting the event and will receive nothing in return. All proceeds go to the artist and to the effort.

To participate in the event, please e-mail high resolution digital images of original art you would like to include in the auction along with the completed information from the attached form to: **director@postofficegallery.com**. Please note that for this event, space is limited so we must ask that work not exceed 30 inches in any direction and that no more than three (3) pieces per artist be submitted. Deadline August 7, Drop off August 13 from 12 – 3.

The Silent Auction begins on August 20 with a reception from 2:00 – 4:00pm and closes with another reception on Sunday September 3 from 2:00 – 4:00pm.
